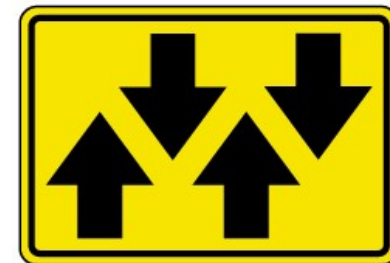

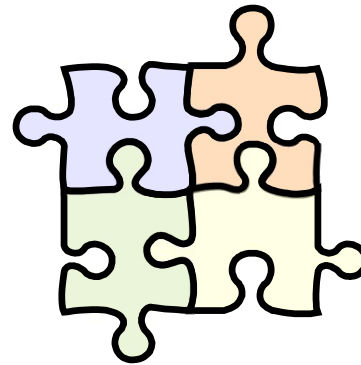

Assessment and Follow-on

- Assessment, Tracking & Analysis Toolkit
 - ◆ Any means addressing roadmap component needs will do (preferably integrating with existing systems)
 - ◆ CSF is Assessee understanding of risks/processes & related controls in his business context (framework translation)
 - ◆ Tracking of consolidated findings and actions is a must
 - ◆ Facility for Consolidation & Analysis of results recommended
 - ◆ Management Information storage/retrieval required
 - ◆ **Automation of chaos = exponential multiplication of frustration at all levels**

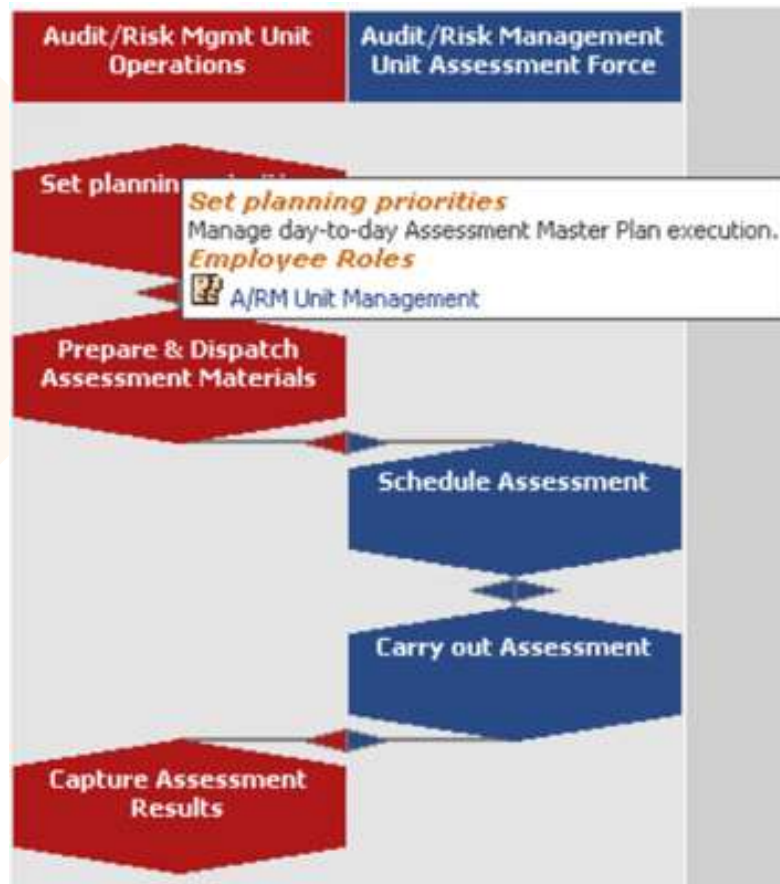

Programme Definition	
Define Programme Objectives:	<p>What are we trying to achieve?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ What are we trying to find and counter? (what keeps us awake at night)■ What reaction times times are required?■ What are the competitive elements?■ What is the investment size required to improve our night rest?
Define Assessment Approach(es):	<p>Do we need</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Field Assessment■ Workshop Assessment■ Self Assessment <p>Do we use</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Bottom-up approach■ Top-down approach <p>Do we need to assess</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Business processes■ Risks■ Product lines■ Product Life Cycles■ Business Units■ Functions■
Set-up Overall Process & Plan (Programme):	<p>Combine Objectives and Approaches into tactics to efficiently and timely detect and react to what keeps us awake at night.</p>
